

## THE BUFFALO SAFARI 7-NIGHT/8-DAY SAFARI

This adventure safari is perfect for those with limited time still wishing to visit the best wilderness areas in Botswana. Starting in Maun and ending in Livingstone, Zambia it offers great value for money.



### HIGHLIGHTS:

- 3 nights Moremi Game Reserve
- 3 nights Chobe National Park
- 1 night at a comfortable lodge in Livingstone, Zambia
- Optional visit to the Victoria Falls, Livingstone, Zambia ( entrance fee US\$ 35, subject to change)
- Starting in Maun – Ending in Livingstone

**Please note:** excluding 1 night hotel in Maun on the day of arrival plus transfers.

### Days 1-3: Moremi Game Reserve, Camping

The safari begins in Maun, where your guide will meet you at 07h30 at a pre-arranged meeting point. From Maun you will drive through to **Moremi Game Reserve**, one of the best wilderness areas of Botswana which covers swamp and dry areas. During a short break en-route, your guide will give you a full overview of your safari. The next three days will be spent searching for the wide variety of wildlife and birds that this area is renowned for while absorbing the sounds and beauty of this region. Game drives in the early morning as the sun rises and in the late afternoon as the sun sets will be the norm. After your morning game drives, you will return to camp for lunch and a siesta. On Day 3 you will move campsites to explore a different area of this diverse park. Camping will be in private designated campsites with bush ablutions. (Day 1: L, D; Days 2 & 3: B, L, D)

Day 1: Maun – Moremi Game Reserve: 150km, 6h (including game drive)

### Days 4-6: Chobe National Park, Camping

**Chobe National Park**, with its diverse and striking landscapes, will be your next destination. As you continue your search for wildlife, you will traverse the drier region of **Savuti** where bull elephants dot the plains. You will then head northwards to the Chobe River where your game drives will meander along the banks of the river, followed by the call of the majestic African Fish Eagle. Camping will be in private designated areas with bush ablutions, first in the Savuti area (Day 4), then in the northern part of the park closer to the riverfront (Day 5 & 6). (B, L, D)

Day 4: Eastern Moremi – Savuti: 120km, 7-8h (transfer and game drive)

Day 5: Savuti - Chobe River: 170km, 5-6h (transfer and game drive)

**Days 7-8: A night in a comfortable lodge in Livingstone (Maramba, The Waterfront or The Bushfront)**

After a morning game drive you will cross the Zambezi River by ferry and then drive to **Livingstone** on the Zambian side of the Victoria Falls (Visa required), where you will spend the night at a comfortable lodge. In the afternoon there will be time to visit the thunderous Victoria Falls and shop for curios. Dinner will be at your own expense at the lodge. The safari officially ends at 10h00 on Day 8.

Zimba Safaris is happy to arrange post-tour accommodation, activities and transfers to Livingstone airport or lodges, Victoria Falls airport or lodges or Kasane, Botswana, at an additional cost. Activities in Livingstone include White Water Rafting down the Zambezi Gorge, Canoeing on the upper Zambezi and Helicopter Flights over the Victoria Falls.  
(Day 7 – B, L & Day 8 - B)

Day 7: Chobe River – Livingstone: 100km, 2-3h (including border crossing)

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**LOW SEASON November – June** € 1.255,- p.p.

**HIGH SEASON July – October** € 1.340,- p.p.

Insurance to cover for cancellation and curtailment, medical, baggage, emergency evacuation, any increase in National Park Fees.

**General information:**

**Safari character:** Adventurous

**Minimum group size:** 1 person

**Maximum group size:** 12 persons

**Group:** international

**Semi participation:** All we ask you to do on your safari is carry your own luggage to/from your tent and to put up/take down your own 'user-friendly' tent. The safari team will take care of all other camp chores and food preparation – just sit back and relax and enjoy the sounds of the bush!

**Luggage restrictions:** 12 kilo - max. size = 700mm x 350mm x 350mm (no hard suitcases) + hand luggage, due to restricted space in the vehicle and trailer or Mokore canoe. Any extra luggage must be left behind and stored. For the storage of luggage in Maun or Livingstone at the start/end of your safari extra costs could be charged.

**Drinks:** Drinks (mineral water, softs and alcohol) are not included on all our camping safaris and are to be bought the day prior if your safari leaves early on day 1 or on the day if your safari starts at 13h00. A minimum 3 litres of drinking water is recommended per person per day. At all hotel/lodge accommodation drinks are on a cash bar basis.

**Meals:** You will enjoy a wide variety of meals during your safari and we attempt to include an 'African' flavor in our safari menus. All meals are cooked on an open fire. Special diets on request.

**Children:** min. age of 12 years

**Single supplement:** Please note that there is a single supplement charge for single travelers. However, if a single guest is willing to share a tent/room with another single guest of the same gender there is no single supplement charge.
